Papers must be camera ready on $8^{1/2} \times 11$ white paper, two-column format in Times or similar font style. 10 points or larger with one inch margins on all four sides. Author's name, addresses, affiliations, telephone/fax/telex numbers should also be included. Do not fold or staple the original camera-ready copy. Papers must be written in English. The author should indicate one or more categories that best describe the topic of the paper. A manuscript submitted for consideration implies a willingness to present the paper at the Symposium. The authors are also asked to indicate their choices for presentation format of the paper: lecture, poster or either.
