

In addition to their long hours of practice, they have gained much experience that will help them through their future years of wrestling.



They sing both pop and traditional songs, and add their melodic talent to many school events. Their fine music is enjoyed by students and faculty alike.



This fine club is under the able leadership of Miss Jean Seidel.






